Refundable Security Deposit for crewed charter: € 2,000 paid in cash to the agent or captain or by credit card verification to the boat owner.

- Sailing time is unlimited during daylight hours
    - Motoring time is usually limited to 4 hours a day, for additional motoring time we charge Euro 15 per hour
  - No night navigation is permitted
